
Day 3:


Day 4:


Day 6:





Day 1: San Francisco to Half Moon Bay

Distance: 47km
Approx. 36 minutes



We begin our California Coastal Cruise from San Francisco, otherwise known as the Golden City. San Francisco is a vibrant and diverse city, with iconic landmarks, steep hills and eclectic neighbourhoods. Our first recommendation is taking the ferry from Pier 33 and experiencing a historic prison on [Alcatraz Island](#). Learn about its notorious inmates whilst enjoying stunning views of San Francisco Bay. Following along from your historic tour, experience one of San Francisco's most popular and iconic landmarks, the [Golden Gate Bridge](#). A popular activity is to go hiking along the Golden Gate National Recreation Area, you can also cross the bridge and enjoy stunning views along the way. For a fun, interactive, learning experience, head to the [Exploratorium](#). This is popular for family activities or any budding scientist. Approx. 57 minutes





Santa Cruz to Monterey


Distance: 68km





Day 5:







Day 1: Dallas To Tyler

Distance: 158km
Approx. 1 hour 35 minutes



We begin our Southern Adventure in the bustling metropolis of Dallas. Known for its rich history, vibrant city and thriving art scene, we believe this is the perfect place to begin this exciting and diverse road trip. Begin your day by visiting [The Sixth Floor Museum at Dealey Plaza](#), an iconic museum, located in the former Texas School Book Depository, showcases the legacy of John F. Kennedy through photographs, artefacts and films. Continuing on, take a stroll through the [Dallas Arboretum & Botanical Garden](#). This lush oasis features beautiful gardens and vibrant floral displays with scenic walkways to see the diverse range of plants and inspired gardens. For a taste of Dallas's modernity, go see the [Reunion Tower](#), the incredible observation tower that offers panoramic views of the city's skyline. Dallas is also well-known for their art, which can be viewed across the city. However, if you are an avid museum and art enthusiast, we also recommend visiting the [Dallas Museum of Art](#). Driving in the USA

- Vehicles drive on the right-hand side of the road.
- **Blood Alcohol Content (BAC) Limit:** The legal BAC limit varies by state, commonly 0.08%. Police are authorized to conduct random alcohol tests on drivers at any time. Motorists found over the limit face severe penalties, including loss of license, vehicle impoundment, fines, and possible imprisonment. If found over the limit during an accident, insurance companies may refuse claims.

Speed Limits and Enforcement:

Speed Limits: Urban Roads: 25-35 mph (40-56 km/h), Rural Roads: 55-70 mph (89-113 km/h), Interstate Highways: 55-75 mph (89-121 km/h). *Speed limits can vary by state and specific road conditions, so always observe posted signs.*

Enforcement: Speeding cameras, handheld devices, and portable detection devices are used by police to catch speeding drivers. Fines are issued for speeding drivers.

Vehicles towing caravans or trailers must adhere to lower speed limits, which vary by state.

- **Toll Roads:** Many highways and bridges in the USA require a toll. Toll prices are usually fixed and can be paid by cash, credit card, prepaid card, or electronic tags (like E-ZPass).

Parking:

Urban Areas: Street parking in major cities like New York and Los Angeles can be challenging to find, and strict restrictions often apply. Off-street parking, such as parking garages and lots, is usually more convenient.

Street Parking: Observe street signs for time limits and restrictions. Parking meters are

Do I need a full driver's license in USA?

A full valid drivers licence is required for a minimum of 1 year (not permitted for any provisional licences)

Do I require an International Driver's permit (IDP)?

Taking an IDP is recommended in the USA and not mandatory. It is important to note an IDP is only valid with a home state licence. If you would like an IDP, this can be done by going to the NRMA, RACQ, RACV, RAA, RAC, RACT and the AANT depending what state you are from.

Is there a minimum or maximum age limit?

Generally the minimum age is 20 or 21 years, it varies between the car hire supplier and vehicle make. Many premium, SUVs, vans and luxury vehicles have a minimum age of 25. For drivers between the ages of 20 - 25 a young driver surcharge (YDS) will apply. Maximum age limits generally do not apply, however please check the terms and conditions when making an enquiry or booking.



Do I Need To Purchase Insurance For The Car?

In the USA all DriveAway vehicles come with nil excess, so you can drive stress-free. So there is no need for extra insurance. DriveAway also offers a [Refundable Breakdown Rate](#) in the USA.

Can I Drive To Canada Or Mexico?

Most car hire companies will allow you to drive to Canada, however the vehicle must be collected and returned back to the US. One ways from the US to Canada and vice versa are not permitted. Some car hire companies will allow you to travel to Tijuana only. One ways from the US to Mexico and vice versa are not permitted. Make sure you check at time of enquiry or booking for any terms and conditions.
